Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared D/S J. MERCER (2781) who being duly sworn alleges, on information and belief, that on the 13TH day of MARCH, 20 21, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

commit:

Count(s) 1-2: Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer

Count(s) 3-4 Resisting arrest with violence

On March 13th, 2021, at approximately 1843 hours, I responded to 44721 Lake Mack Dr. Deland in reference to a stabbing that had occurred. Upon arrival, I found the decedent, identified as Ronal Wells Sr. on the front porch of the residence and the arrestee, Kolby Parker standing to his side. [REDACTED] Mr. Parker had [REDACTED] he was attacked by Mr. Wells Sr. with a knife. Mr. Parker advised [REDACTED] that he was able to disarm Mr. Wells Sr. and used the knife, stabbing Mr. Wells Sr. in the "heart." The decedent was covered in blood, had partial degloving to the right forearm, and exhibited no pulse or indication of breathing. Mr. Parker was asked to wait outside of the porch so that I could continue the search for vitals; however, none were found, and Mr. Wells Sr. was pronounced on scene by this deputy.

In having a noncustodial conversation with Mr. Parker, he advised that he and Mr. Wells Sr. were smoking marijuana and had gotten into a verbal altercation. Mr. Parker claims that Mr. Wells Sr. produced a kitchen knife and "came at him with it." Mr. Parker advised that he was able to disarm Mr. Parker and used the knife against Mr. Wells. Mr. Parker had no wounds that could be observed and originally declined EMS service. Mr. Parker was asked if he had any weapons on him, to which he replied, "yes." A pat-down was performed, which yielded no weapons, only an unknown object in each pocket. This object was soft to the touch while being firm; however, it was not removed.

I asked Mr. Parker if he knew the whereabouts of Mr. Ronal Wells Jr., to which Mr. Parker, after a moment of silence, asked this deputy, "Do you want to know where Ronal Wells Jr. is?" to which I respond, "yes." Mr. Parker then reached into his left and right front pockets and removed the previously mentioned objects.

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared D/S J. MERCER (2781) who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 13TH day of MARCH, 2021, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

Continued:

These items were immediately identified as the left and right earlobes and outer ear belonging to a human. Mr. Parker stated, "this is where he is." As the ear remnants were taken as evidence, Mr. Parker then asked this deputy, "Can I have your gun?" to which I replied, "no." Mr. Parker sat in silence for a few moments and then attacked D/S Mally (2765), grabbing both D/S Mally's Taser and Firearm with each hand attempting to remove them. I and D/S Mally tried to redirect Mr. Parker to the ground; however, Mr. Parker began kicking, striking, and posturing to resist efforts to take him into custody. While fighting with Mr. Parker, he was repeatedly told to stop resisting, informed that he was being placed under arrest, and continued to attempt to retrieve a firearm from the secured holster of deputies. An agency-issued Taser 7 was used but was not effective.

Mr. Parker was placed in handcuffs; however, he continued to kick at deputies, striking myself and D/S Mally with his feet on several occasions until shackles could be affixed. Mr. Parker was transported by Lake EMS following this event and was accompanied by D/S Williams (2707).

Once Mr. Parker was medically cleared, he was transported to the Lake County Jail. The scene continues to be active at this time. The incident in its entirety was captured on an agency-issued bodycam. This deputy is seeking a "No Bond" hold due to the extreme nature of the originating call for service, and the arrestee's direct involvement.

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared _____ who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 13TH day of MARCH, 2021, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

commit: 2nd degree Murder (Domestic Violence) FSS: 782.04 (2)

On March 13, 2021 at approximately 1841 hours, a 911 caller [REDACTED]

On March 13, 2021 at approximately 1841 hours, Lake County Sheriff's Office responded the area of 44721 Lake Mack Drive, Deland, Lake County, Florida, 32720 in reference to a stabbing complaint.

Upon arrival, Deputy Sheriff Mercer (2781) observed the decedent, Ronal Wells Sr. lying on the front porch of the residence with four (4) stab wounds to chest and the suspect, Kolby Parker standing next the decedent with bloody hands and arms. Deputy Mercer determined the victim was not breathing and did not have a pulse. Deputies did not notice any physical injuries to the suspect and had a non-custodial conversation with the suspect, Kolby Parker and he advised he and his grandfather, Ronal Wells Sr. were smoking marijuana on the front porch and got into a verbal argument. Kolby further stated that the marijuana may have been laced with an unknown substance. Kolby advised his grandfather (victim) attacked him with a knife and he wrestled the knife away from his, grandfather. Kolby advised he proceeded to stab his grandfather in the chest with the knife. This was consistent with the information provided to 911 by the person identifying himself as [REDACTED] who was not present at the scene. Deputy Mercer searched the suspect, Kolby and did not located any weapon and noticed an unidentified soft object in Kolby's front pockets. Deputy Mercer asked Kolby where his Uncle, Ronal Wells Jr. was located and Kolby removed two (2) bloody human ears from his pockets and stated "this is were he is." Kolby held the ears out in both hands and Deputy Mercer photographed the ears. Kolby gave the ears to Deputy Mercer and Deputy Mercer proceeded to place the ears in an evidence bag. Kolby asked Deputy Mercer for his firearm and lunged at Deputy Mally, grabbing at the deputies Taser and firearm. Kolby proceeded to punch, kick and head butt three (3) deputies. Deputies secured the suspect and arrested him for battery on a law enforcement officer. Kolby was transported to Advent Health Waterman Hospital for treatment.

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared Detective J.C. Watkins 209 who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 13TH day of MARCH, 2021, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

Deputies entered the porch and observed the victim, Ronal Wells Sr. was missing both his ears. Deputies entered the residence to search for Kolby's uncle and observed blood drops on the floor and a kitchen knife lying on the table. Deputies observed a large Pitbull dog inside the residence and LCSO Animal Control removed the dog from the residence. Deputies secured the residence and notified Criminal and Crime Scene Investigation to responded.

Detective Watkins obtained a search warrant for the residence and on the front porch Detectives observed the seventy six (76) year old victim, Ronal Wells Sr. with multiple stab wounds to the chest. Detectives observed cutting wounds on the victim's arms and hands which were consistent with defensive wounds. Detectives observed the victim's ears had been removed. Detectives located an aluminum baseball bat with blood like stains in the corner of the porch. Detectives observed a large wooden handle kitchen knife on the kitchen table and dripped blood on the kitchen floor. Detectives noticed dripped blood in the kitchen sink. Detectives noticed a cooking apron with the phrase "The Family Butcher" hanging on the suspect's bedroom wall. Detectives noticed the same apron had plastic human bloody ears attached to the apron.

Crime Scene Investigators photographed, processed and collected evidence from the scene. Investigators conducted a completed forensic examination of the victim and the victim was transported to the Fifth District Medical Examiner's Office for an autopsy to be performed.

The suspect, Kolby Parker provided a post Miranda sworn audio recorded statement stating he and the victim were smoking marijuana at the kitchen table. Kolby admitted to retrieving a baseball bat and striking the victim in the head multiple times with the baseball bat knocking the victim to the ground. The suspect admitted to retrieving a butcher knife from the table and stabbing the victim in the neck and chest multiple times. Kolby admitted to cutting off the victim's ears but denied cutting the victim's arm. Kolby advised he wanted his grandfather to be with his deceased grandmother and it was his time to go.
