31 / 14. Housekeeping	<p>Please clarify the nursing staff will be responsible for cleaning the cells including mattresses and bunks, and removing trash and dirty linens? This would result in our nurses needing extra training and time to perform those housekeeping functions.</p>
32 / 19. Contaminated Waste Disposal	<p>Please clarify whether this is only contaminated waste generated by or due to medical care or does it include disposal of general bio-hazard waste generated from custody (i.e., razors, dirty mattresses, biohazard spills due to fights or suicides)?</p>
